Addendum

Additional consideration to justify your nominations using the following:

- 1. To review the last 2 or 3 SEA Games and look at the trend in results and trend in the number of athletes selected per sport.
- 2. Extend the selection window back to include results from SEA Games 2019. (Top 3 finish)
- 3. NSA's assessment and projection at the 31st SEA Games

In view of the Covid-19 pandemic, SNOC will assess nominations based on a wider parameter {which are points 1 to 2 above}. The NSA's addendum to our Selection Policy is as

Follow below

2021 SEA Games - PETANQUE

Selection Criteria

Sports Boules Singapore will nominate athletes for the Petanque events which will be held at the 2021 SEA Games based on the following criteria:

- 1. Be a Singapore Citizen, and at least 11 years old and above as of 31 Dec 2020. (The athlete should not be holding dual citizenship if they are 21 years old, at the time of nomination).
- 2. Attained a score equivalent to the bronze medal score of the last SEA Games in which event was last held, in any one of the approved meets.
- 3. Beat the 3rd placed Players in the last SEA Games in which the event was last held, in any one of the approved competitions from December 2019 to December 2020.
- 4. Attendance expected to participate for training will be at least 75%

5. Attendance expected to participate after selection will be 75%

The approved international competitions are:

- 23-26 May 2019 32nd Port Authority of Thailand
- 18-24 Nov 2019 17th juniors and Women World Championships
- 03-09 Aug 2020 World Petanque Offline Cup

Other Considerations

In addition to the above selection criteria, the following "qualities" of the athletes will be taken into consideration:

- Attitude and behaviour towards coaches, teammates, fellow athletes, officials and sports
 Administrators, whether in relation to sporting matters or otherwise;
- General conduct and character which may affect the reputation, image, values or best Interests of the athlete or the sport;
- Past disciplinary record;
- Current skill level and fitness;
- Level of commitment and attendance;
- Potential for future development;
- Ability to demonstrate team spirit and work well with team mates and officials

Extenuating Circumstances

In consideration of the performance and "qualities" of athletes, the selectors may at their discretion give consideration to extenuating circumstances. For this purpose, "extenuating circumstances mean an inability of the athlete to compete in and/or attend event, training camps or other required attendances arising from:

- Injury or illness;
- Equipment failure;
- Travel delays;
- Bereavement;
- Such other circumstances as the selectors may consider to be relevant

Appeals

- The appeal process shall be made as a process of enquiry against the selection process, policies and decision. It does not serve as a reselection process.
- Any appeal must be written officially to Sports Boules Singapore within 5 working days after the official announcement of the selection results.
- A deposit payment of \$\$100.00 (payment by cheque) has to be submitted together with the appeal. The deposit will not be refunded if the selection result is upheld.
- The Appeal Panel shall consist of the SBS Secretary-General and 2 Committee members from Sports Boules Singapore without any conflict of interest.
- The Appeal Panel's decision is final.
